## KILLARA GOLF CLUB DRESS CODE & COURSE CARE

### *DRESS CODE*

#### **Lower Bar and BBQ Area**

Smart casual wear including denim jeans and skirts, cargo shorts, boat shoes without socks and untucked collared shirts.

#### **Dining Room**

A jacket with tie is preferred, but smart casual wear is acceptable.

Members will be kept informed on the standard acceptable for special functions.

Please call Reception if you have any queries.

#### **Tennis and Squash Courts**

Recognised tennis and squash attire, which is predominantly white, must be worn.

Shirts must have collars and be tucked in.

### **Course**

#### **Men's**

Tailored shorts and trousers are acceptable. Ankle length short socks at least 10cm above shoe line, or ankle socks, must be worn with tailored shorts. Shirts with minimum logo only must have collars and be tucked in.

#### **Ladies'**

Please observe the following dress regulations for golf:

- Recognised golf attire, in keeping with that designed as golf wear, such as is stocked by club professionals and golf wear retailers
- The length of shorts and skirts should be at least mid thigh
- Garments with belt loops should be worn with a belt
- Collared shirts should be tucked in unless of a fitted style designed to be worn over pants, skirts or shorts.
- Fitted style collared shirts should be no more than 10cm below the belt line

#### **The following golf attire is not acceptable:**

- Mini skirts and short shorts
- Singlet tops and shirts without collars
- Denim, irrespective of colour, any jean-style or studded pants, drawstring pants, stirrup pants, leggings, cargo-style pants, pedal pushers or tracksuits or corduroy.
- Caps are not acceptable in the Clubhouse

### *COURSE CARE*

The following points are provided to assist in the upkeep of the course and promote proper etiquette so that you and your fellow members have an enjoyable round of golf. They are not the responsibility of grounds staff.

- Sand buckets must be carried and used at all times. They are provided near the 1st tee, 9th tee & 9th car park. Sand bins are also located on all tees and throughout the course.
- Repair all plug marks on greens with a pitch repairer.
- Enter and leave bunkers from the lowest access point, generally the back of the bunker or a tongue.
- Once footprints are raked out do not leave the rake against the edge of the bunker.
- Do not lean on your putter when on the green.
- Do not wheel buggies across greens.
- Please repair and fill all divots left on fairways.
